

## HASTY HILLS FARM EQUINE DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAMS

### 2017 NOMINATION FORM

#### \*Show Management Information\*

In order to provide a great step for our local equestrians between schooling shows and the rated shows, Hasty Hills Farm has launched three incentive programs with seven divisions, giving competitors the chance to work towards championships and financial awards at the end of the 2017 season.

Below you will find information regarding the incentives, and included in your packet you will find the \*Exhibitor Information\* forms (two pages).

**If your show would like to offer these incentive qualifying classes, Show Management must contact us within 30 days of your event** in order to be added to the competition calendar, announced and marketed, and to receive any additional instructions and assistance you may require.

#### What You Need to Host Qualifying Classes:

- Make sure all participating horses have completed nomination forms and are enrolled in the incentive programs. If a horse is not yet enrolled, you'll need to provide the \*Exhibitor Information\* forms to the owner for it to be completed before the horse may participate in your show's qualifying classes and the incentive programs.
  - *How Hasty Hills will Help:*
    - *We'll have a list of nominated horses and their divisions available for you to access!*
- Remember that nomination registration forms must be completed prior to the qualifying classes – points will not be allocated retroactively.
- You are under no obligation to offer all phases of the Qualifying Divisions. We understand that time constraints can be prohibitive, however the flat and conformation classes are encouraged.
- Qualifying classes may run concurrently with similar classes at your show, though it is encouraged to have stand-alone classes. Open numerical scoring for nominated entries will be announced for each class.

- Completed Registration / Nomination Forms must be completed and return them to Hasty Hills along with appropriate collected nomination fees in a timely manner please.
  - The nomination fee schedule is as follows:
    - February 10 through March 31: \$40 per incentive program division
    - April 1 through July 15: fee is \$60 per incentive program division
    - July 16 through August 25: fee is \$80 per incentive program division
- Qualifying shows must report results to Hasty Hills Farm within 10 days of the event. These results may be emailed to [hastyhillsfarm@rochester.rr.com](mailto:hastyhillsfarm@rochester.rr.com)
  - Each qualifying class will be judged on an open numerical scoring system. Points will be awarded as follows:
    - Classes with fewer than 6 entries: 15-10-7-5-3-1
    - Classes with 7 or more entries: 20-15-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-2
  - *How Hasty Hills will Help:*
    - *We will track and total all points for nominated horses in qualifying classes!*
- Show Management must set aside \$5 per entry of nominated horses for all qualifying classes, which will go towards the Incentive Program for marketing, administration and point-keeping database management, rider awards, and judging expenses for the Finals. Funds should be provided to Hasty Hills Farm no later than 10 days after your show.
- Awards, announcement, and presentations must be given for all qualifying classes at all qualifying shows.

Hasty Hills is currently building relationships with local and regional sponsors for these great incentive programs. As new sponsors come on board, we will advise you so that announcements can be made at your show.
