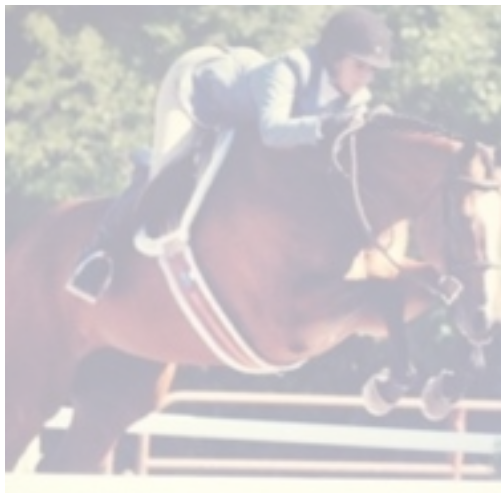


HHF EQUINE DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE FUND 2017 RESULTS

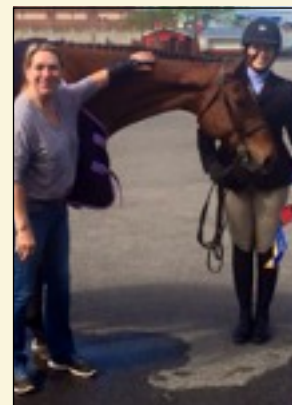
About Soft Parade-

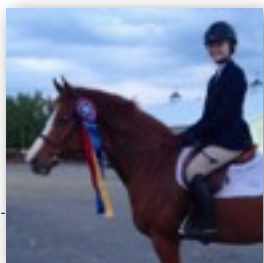
